Booen previously served as vice president of Aviall Defense for two years. Aviall is a wholly owned subsidiary of Boeing. Aviall Defense supports more than 50 military branches in 30 countries around the world, ensuring fleet operational readiness and peak aircraft performance.

Prior to Aviall, Booen held vice president positions for 13 years with Raytheon Missile Systems, where he was a product line vice president responsible for developing the front end of Raytheon's missile defense business and directed energy weapons. While at Raytheon, Booen developed an expansive missile defense and directed energy business. Earlier in his career, Booen was selected as a space shuttle astronaut for the Air Force's Manned Spaceflight Engineer program.

Booen retired as a colonel from Air Force, where he led two of the USAF's largest ACAT 1D acquisition programs. Booen has a bachelor's degree in mechanical

engineering from the U.S. Air Force Academy and a master's degree in engineering from Stanford University.
